Reasons for this finding: This rule change is necessary to ensure a successful youth fishing event. Several thousand rainbow trout will be stocked prior to the event for acclimation. This helps ensure they will bite while the kids are fishing. During the event, only registered kids will be allowed to fish. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.

NEW SECTION

WAC 220-312-05000E Exceptions to statewide rules—Sarg Hubbard Park (aka Reflection) Pond.

Notwithstanding the provisions of and WAC 220-312-050, effective 12:01 a.m. April 17, through 4:00 p.m. April 20, 2019, it is unlawful to fish in Sarg Hubbard Park Pond, except as provided in the sections below:

- (a) Open to fishing 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. April 20, 2019, by juvenile anglers participating in the Yakima Greenway Association's "Kids' Fish-In" event.
- (b) The daily limit is reduced to two (2) trout during the youth fishing event.
