Reasons for this finding: This rule is needed to close salmon fishing for the Cowlitz River, Lewis River, Cispus River
and Lake Scanewa, reduce the daily adult salmon limit for the Kalama River.
The 2020 Cowlitz River spring Chinook run forecast is 1,400 adult fish. Based on this forecast, the Cowlitz
Salmon Hatchery is not expected to meet its broodstock goals. Closing the Chinook salmon fishing season in the
lower Cowlitz River will increase the number of hatchery fish available for broodstock and help ensure future
hatchery returns. Based on the forecast, we do not expect to have hatchery Chinook to transport above Cowlitz
Falls Dam to support an upper Cowlitz river salmon fishery.
The 2020 Kalama River spring Chinook forecast is 1,000 adult fish. Managers need to reduce the adult salmon

daily limit to one adult Chinook in order to ensure hatchery broodstock goals are achieved. Reducing the adult salmon daily limit will provide continued opportunity for anglers to harvest spring Chinook and help ensure future hatchery returns. The 2020 Lewis River spring Chinook run forecast is 1,300 adult fish. Based on this forecast, the Lewis Hatchery is not expected to meet its broodstock goals. Closing the salmon fishing season in the Lewis River will increase the number of hatchery fish available for broodstock and help ensure future hatchery returns.

## NEW SECTION

## WAC 220-312-03000I Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Southwest.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-030, effective March 1, 2020 until further notice:

- (1) Cispus River (Lewis Co.): Chinook Salmon: closed.
- (2) Cowlitz Falls Reservoir (Lake Scanewa) (Lewis Co.): Chinook Salmon: closed.
- (3) Cowlitz River (Cowlitz Co.): Chinook Salmon: closed.
- (4) **Kalama River** (**Cowlitz Co.**): From the mouth upstream to 1000 feet below the fishway at the upper salmon hatchery: Salmon: Daily limit 6; up to 1 may be an adult. Release all salmon other than hatchery Chinook and hatchery coho.
- (5) Lewis River (Clark/Cowlitz Co.): Salmon: closed.
