NEW SECTION

WAC 220-312-02000C Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Coast.

Effective June 6 through September 15, 2020, the following provisions of WAC 220-312-020(41) and (42), regarding recreational fishing seasons for the Hoh River and Hoh River, South Fork, shall be as described below. All other provisions of WAC 220-312-020 not addressed herein, or unless otherwise amended, remain in effect:

- (1) Hoh River from the Olympic National Park boundary near the mouth upstream to Olympic National Park boundary above Morgan's Crossing boat launch: Closed waters.
- (2) Hoh River, South Fork, from mouth upstream to Olympic National Park boundary: Closed waters.

The following section of Washington Administrative Code is repealed effective September 16: WAC 220-312-02000C Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Coast.
