## NEW SECTION

#### WAC 220-312-06000Q Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Columbia

Effective July 4 through July 31, 2020, provisions of WAC 220-312-060 regarding Columbia River salmon and steelhead seasons from the Interstate 182 Bridge to Priest Rapids Dam are modified as described below. All other provisions of WAC 220-312-060 not addressed herein or otherwise amended by emergency rule remain in effect.

## From the Interstate 182 Bridge to Priest Rapids Dam:

Salmon: Effective July 4 through July 31, 2020: Daily limit is 2 salmon. Release coho and wild adult Chinook.
