Leasons for this finding: This emergency rule is needed to close Marine Area 7 to Chinook retention from August 16							
through August 21, 2020. With 206 Chinook remaining of the Catch Record Card Area 7 quota of 1,562, it is unlikely the							
fishery could endure the entirety of the scheduled season, from August 16 through August 31, 2020. This closure is intended to maximize opportunity and participation while ensuring fisheries remain within allowed ESA impacts. The decision for this							
closure and its timing were made in consultation with the citizens' board of the Puget Sound Sport Fishing Advisory Group.							
Immediate adoption of this rule is necessary fort the preservation of public health safety, or general welfare. Observing the							
requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the public							
nterest. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.

NEW SECTION

WAC 220-313-06000V Puget Sound salmon—saltwater seasons and daily limits.
