WAC 220-313-07000A Coastal salmon—Saltwater seasons and daily limits.

Effective September 4 through September 30, 2020 the provisions of WAC 220-313-070 regarding recreational salmon seasons for Marine Areas 1, 2 and 4 shall be as described below. All other provisions of WAC 220-313-070 not addressed herein remain in effect unless otherwise amended by emergency rule:

- (1) Catch Record Card Area 1: Closed.
- (2) Catch Record Card Area 2:
 - (a) Daily limit 2 salmon.
 - (b) Release wild Coho.
 - (c) Chinook minimum size 22 inches.
- (3) Catch Record Card Area 4: Closed.
