#### WAC 220-312-04000T Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Puget Sound.

Effective 12:01 a.m. September 21 until 6:00 p.m September 22, 2020, the following provisions of WAC 220-312-040 regarding recreational fishing seasons for the Skagit River from Highway 9 Bridge to the mouth of the Baker River, shall be as described below. All other provisions of WAC 220-312-040 not addressed herein, or unless otherwise amended, remain in effect:

Skagit River (Skagit Co.) from Highway 9 Bridge to the mouth of the Baker River:

All species: Closed.
