WAC 220-330-04000P Crab--Areas and Seasons—Personal use.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-330-040, effective immediately through December 31, 2020, Puget Sound recreational crab seasons are as listed below. All other provisions of WAC 220-330-040 not addressed herein remain in effect unless otherwise amended by emergency rule:

It is permissible to crab for personal use in the following Marine Areas: 4 East of the Bonilla-Tatoosh line, 5, 6, 7, 9, and 12.
