Agency: Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW)

Subject of possible rule making: The department is considering a recommendation to classify Oregon vesper sparrow, island marble butterfly, and Cascade red fox as state endangered, threatened, or sensitive (WAC 220-610-010 and WAC 220-200-100).

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject:

RCW 77.04.012, 77.04.013, 77.04.020, 77.04.055, 77.12.047, and 77.12.240.

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: The department is responsible for making recommendations regarding listing status of certain animal species, and if those species should be classified as sensitive threatened, or endangered. To properly classify the status of the Oregon vesper sparrow, island marble butterfly, and Cascade red fox the department will review all relevant data pertaining to the population status and factors affecting existence in Washington state. Initial review indicates that the species have declined significantly and multiple factors negatively affect their continued existence in Washington.

Identify other federal and state agencies that regulate this subject and the process coordinating the rule with these agencies: For Oregon vesper sparrow, island marble butterfly, and Cascade red fox federal and state agencies that regulate or support occurrences of this species include the US Fish and Wildlife Service, US Department of Defense, National Park Service, and US Forest Service. The department will coordinate with appropriate federal and state agencies during the review period.
