Purpose: The purpose of this rule is to close commercial gillnet and purse seine fisheries in Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Areas 10, 11 12, 12B, and 12C.

Reasons for this finding: This emergency rule is needed to adjust commercial gillnet and purse seine salmon fisheries in Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Areas 10, 11, 12, 12B, and 12C.
Fishery openings planned in Area 10 and 11 are contingent on a test fishery based run-size update that predicts sufficient harvestable surplus, and in-season agreement from Tribal Co-managers as agreed to in the 2020-21 List of Agreed to Fisheries (LOAF). An agreement on non-treaty commercial harvest targeting chum salmon could not be reached in-season between co-managers.
In-season information for non-tribal commercial chum fisheries in Marine Areas 12 and 12B have indicated a run size of 354,358 which leaves a non-tribal share of 130,398 chum. To date the non-treaty total harvest of chum is 54,191. These catches are well below the pre-season expected catch to date and the state believes the run size may be lower than what the in-season information indicates. The state agreed to close its fisheries to contribute to natural escapement goals and hatchery broodstock goals of chum salmon.
