EMERGENCY RULE

Under RCW 34.05.350 the agency for good cause finds:

- That immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the public interest.
- That state or federal law or federal rule or a federal deadline for state receipt of federal funds requires immediate adoption of a rule.

Reasons for this finding: This emergency rule is needed to close fishing within the Hoodspport Hatchery Zone. Fishery managers estimate that the 2020 fall chum run is about 1/3 of the way through normal run timing while the hatchery has only achieved 10% of broodstock needs. This rule is necessary to ensure hatchery broodstock goals are met. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.

NEW SECTION

WAC 220-313-06000Y Puget Sound salmon—saltwater seasons and daily limits.

Effective November 9, 2020 through November 30, 2020, the following provisions of WAC 220-313-060 regarding fishing seasons for the Hoodsport Hatchery Zone in Marine Area 12 shall be modified as described below. All other provisions of WAC 220-313-060 not addressed herein, or unless otherwise amended by emergency rule, remain in effect:

Catch Record Card Area 12: Waters within a 2,000 foot arc seaward of yellow buoys at the mouth of Finch Creek at Hoodsport Salmon Hatchery: Closed Waters.
