### NEW SECTION

### WAC 220-312-06000G Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Columbia River.

Effective January 8, 2021, until further notice, the provisions of WAC 220-312-060 regarding white sturgeon retention seasons from Bonneville Dam to John Day Dam are as follows. All other provisions of WAC 220-312-060 not addressed herein remain in effect unless otherwise amended by emergency rule:

- (1) From Bonneville Dam to The Dalles Dam: Sturgeon retention is prohibited.
- (2) From The Dalles Dam to John Day Dam: Sturgeon retention is prohibited.
