## WAC 220-312-06000A Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Columbia River.

Effective September 18 through September 25, 2021 the provisions of WAC 220-312-060, WAC 220-312-030, and WAC 220-316-010 regarding white sturgeon retention seasons from the Wauna powerline crossing upstream to Bonneville Dam are as follows. All other provisions of WAC 220-312-060, WAC 220-316-010, and WAC 220-312-030 not addressed herein remain in effect unless otherwise amended by emergency rule:

From Wauna powerlines upstream to Bonneville Dam, including the Cowlitz River:

- (a) It is permissible to retain white sturgeon on Saturday September 18, Sunday September 19, Wednesday September 22, Saturday September 25, and Wednesday September 29, 2021:
  - (i) The daily limit of white sturgeon is one fish.
  - (ii) Minimum fork length 44 inches. Maximum fork length 50 inches.
- (b) Catch and release angling for sturgeon is permissible on days and in areas not open to sturgeon retention.
