Purpose of the proposal and its anticipated effects, including any changes in existing rules: Rule amendments are proposed as necessary to implement RCW 77.55.480. This statute was passed into law as Engrossed Second Substitute House Bill 1382 (Laws of 2021, c. 75) during the 2021 legislative session. The statute creates a habitat recovery pilot program. The program provides a streamlined permitting process so that qualified habitat recovery projects may advance to construction quickly and efficiently, thereby creating jobs and further bolstering the natural resources and natural resource economy. WDFW will evaluate qualified HPA project applications according to the process described in statute. Other aspects of chapter 220-660 WAC remain unchanged.				
Reasons supporting proposal: This rule proposal adopts the habitat recovery pilot program by reference to statute. The expedited proposal ensures that the pilot program is implemented quickly, allowing it to be fully functional for the longest duration possible before its designated sunset date.
