WAC 220-313-06000R Puget Sound salmon—saltwater seasons and daily limits.

Effective January 1 through March 31, 2022, the following provisions of WAC 220-313-060 regarding salmon seasons in Catch Record Card Area 10 shall be as described below. All other provisions of WAC 220-313-060 not addressed herein, or unless otherwise amended by emergency rule, remain in effect:

Catch Record Card Area 10: Salmon:

- (a) Open Saturdays, Sundays, and Mondays each week. Closed Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays each week.
- (b) Daily limit 1.
- (c) Chinook, minimum size 22 inches. Other salmon species, no minimum size.
- (d) Release wild Chinook.
