Reasons for this finding: Sea cucumber quotas for the 2021-22 commercial harvest season have been reached in all districts and/or remaining quotas are insufficient to support additional harvest. This emergency rule closes harvest of sea cucumber in catch reporting areas 23B, 25A, 25B, 25C, 25D, and 25E of sea cucumber management Districts 1 and 2. This closure is needed to fulfill obligations of state and tribal co-manager agreements. Immediate adoption of this rule is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare. Observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to public interest. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.
