## WAC 220-340-12000H Commercial Razor clams.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-340-120, effective April 1 through June 10, 2022, a person may dig for and possess razor clams for commercial purposes only in those waters and detached beaches of Razor Clam Area 2 lying south of the Willapa Bay Ship Channel, west of Ellen Sands, and north of the tip of Leadbetter Point. Access to Razor Clam Area 2 is by boat only.

## REPEALER

The following section of the Washington Administrative Code is repealed effective June 11, 2022:

WAC 220-340-12000H Commercial Razor Clams.
