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WAC 220-312-03000Q Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Southwest.

Effective September 16 through December 31, 2022, the provisions of WAC 220-312-030 regarding Yale Reservoir shall be modified as described below. All other provisions of WAC 220-312-030 not addressed herein remain in effect unless otherwise amended by emergency rule:

Yale Reservoir (Cowlitz Co.): Landlocked salmon rules apply, except salmon maximum length is 15 inches.
