NEW SECTION

WAC 220-312-03000H Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Southwest.

Effective October 6 through October 31, 2022, the provisions of WAC 220-312-030 regarding Drano Lake steelhead retention shall be modified during times and as described below. All other provisions of WAC 220-312-030 not addressed herein remain in effect unless otherwise amended by emergency rule:

Drano Lake (Skamania Co.): Downstream of markers on a point of land downstream and across from Little White Salmon National Fish Hatchery and upstream of the Highway 14 bridge:

Salmon and hatchery steelhead: Effective October 6 through October 31, 2022: Daily limit 6; of which up to 1 may be an adult salmon or hatchery steelhead.
