WAC 220-320-12000A Commercial crab fishery--Puget Sound Crustacean (crab and shrimp) Special Management Areas.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-320-120, effective immediately, until further notice, the waters of the Dungeness Bay Crustacean Special Management Area shall be as described herein. All other provisions of WAC 220-320-120 not addressed herein, or unless otherwise amended by emergency rule, remain in effect:

Dungeness Bay CSMA is defined as: All waters of Dungeness Bay west of the -123.1103° (123° 6.6' W) longitude line (a true north/south line through the New Dungeness Lighthouse).
