| Reasons for this finding: The District 2-1 commercial sea cucumber quota is expected to be harvested by the end of the day January 29, 2023. This emergency rule closes harvest of sea cucumber in all management Districts because there is no harvestable surplus remaining. This concludes the 2022-23 sea cucumber harvest season. Immediate adoption of this rule is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare. Observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to public interest. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules. |
