Reasons for this finding: This emergency rule closes commercial harvest of sea urchins in all Sea Urchin Districts. At this time the urchin spawning period is near its peak, resulting in poor quality product for the market; while District 1 has green urchin quota remaining, all other Districts have been closed as their quotas were reached. Immediate adoption of this rule is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare. Observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to public interest. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.
