NEW SECTION

WAC 220-312-05000F Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Eastside.

Effective August 1, through October 1, 2023, the following provisions of WAC 220-312-050, regarding gamefish seasons, size restrictions, and daily limits shall be modified as follows. All other provisions of WAC 220-312-050 remain in effect unless modified by emergency rule:

- (1) Williams Lake (Stevens County): Open for gamefish. No size restrictions, no daily limit for gamefish.
- (2) June Lake (Grant County): No size restrictions, no daily limit for gamefish.
- (3) North Windmill Lake (Grant County): No size restrictions, no daily limit for gamefish.
- (4) North Windmill Lake (Grant County): No size restrictions, no daily limit for gamefish.
