NEW SECTION

WAC 220-313-06000K Puget Sound salmon—saltwater seasons and daily limits.

Effective immediately, through September 30, 2023, the following provisions of WAC 220-313-060 regarding salmon seasons for Catch Record Card Area 11, shall be modified as described below. All other provisions of WAC 220-313-060 not addressed herein, or unless otherwise amended by emergency rule, remain in effect:

(1) Catch Record Card Area 11, except Des Moines Pier, Les Davis Pier, Point Defiance Boathouse Dock:

Effective immediately, through September 30: Salmon daily limit is 2, plus 2 additional pink salmon. Release Chinook and chum.

(2) Des Moines Pier, Les Davis Pier, Point Defiance Boathouse Dock:

Effective immediately, through September 30: Salmon daily limit is 2 including no more than 1 Chinook, plus 2 additional pink salmon. Release chum.

REPEALER

The following section of Washington Administrative Code is repealed, effective immediately: WAC 220-313-06000F Puget Sound salmon—saltwater seasons and daily limits. (23-155)
