WAC 220-354-18000E Reef Net open periods.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-354-180, effective October 1 through November 11, 2023, it is unlawful to take, fish for, or possess salmon taken with reef net gear for commercial purposes in Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Areas except as provided in this section:

Open to reef net gear according to the times, dates and conditions contained herein:

Area(s)	Date(s)	Open/Closed	Daily open period
7	10/1 – 11/11	Open	5:00 a.m. – 9 p.m.

- (a) It is unlawful to retain Chinook and unmarked coho.
- (b) Marked coho are those with a missing adipose fin with a healed scar, unmarked coho have an intact adipose fin.
- (c) All other saltwater and freshwater areas Closed.
