## WAC 220-312-03000G Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Southwest.

Effective October 6 through November 30, 2023, the provisions of WAC 220-312-030 regarding Green River, Toutle River and Toutle River, North Fork salmon fishing seasons shall be modified during times and areas as described below. All other provisions of WAC 220-312-030, not addressed herein, remain in effect unless otherwise amended by emergency rule:

(1) Green River (Cowlitz/Lewis Co.); From the mouth to the boundary signs 400 feet below to the hatchery weir while the weir is installed in the river:

Salmon: Daily limit 6 hatchery coho, including no more than 3 adults. Release all salmon other than hatchery coho.

(2) Toutle River (Cowlitz Co.): From the mouth to forks:

Salmon: Daily limit 6 hatchery coho, including no more than 3 adults. Release all salmon other than hatchery coho.

(3) **Toutle River, North Fork (Cowlitz Co.):** From the mouth to boundary signs posted 400 feet downstream of the hatchery weir:

Salmon: Daily limit 6 hatchery coho, including no more than 3 adults. Release all salmon other than hatchery coho.
