## WAC 220-312-06000Z Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Columbia River.

Effective November 1 through December 31, 2023, the provisions of WAC 220-312-060 regarding recreational salmon seasons from I-182 Bridge to the Old Hanford townsite powerline crossing, shall be modified during the dates listed and as described below. All year-round Closed Waters areas remain in effect. Other provisions of WAC 220-312-060 not addressed herein remain in effect unless otherwise amended by emergency rule:

From I-182 Bridge to the Old Hanford townsite powerline crossing:

Salmon: November 1 through December 31, 2023: Daily limit 6. Up to 2 adults including no more than 1 adult Chinook may be retained. Release all salmon other than Chinook and coho.
