WAC 220-330-16000E Razor clams – Areas and Seasons.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-330-160, it is unlawful to take, dig for or possess razor clams taken for personal use from any beaches in any razor clam area except as provided for in this section:

(1) Effective 12:01 p.m. October 27 through 11:59 p.m. October 31, 2023, razor clam digging is permissible in Razor Clam Areas defined in WAC 220-330-160 during evening tides on dates and times listed below:

Area 1	October 27 through 30	From 12:01 p.m. to 11:59 p.m.
Area 2	Closed	Closed
Area 3	October 27 through 30	From 12:01 p.m. to 11:59 p.m.
Area 4	October 28 and 30	From 12:01 p.m. to 11:59 p.m.
Area 5	October 27, 29 and 31	From 12:01 p.m. to 11:59 p.m.
Area 6	Closed	Closed
Area 7	Closed	Closed

(2) It is unlawful to dig for razor clams at any time in the Long Beach and Copalis Beach Clam sanctuaries defined in WAC 220-320-130.
