NEW SECTION

WAC 220-340-73000M Sea Cucumbers

Effective January 22 through February 4, 2024, the following provisions of WAC 220-340-730 regarding Puget Sound commercial sea cucumber harvest and sales shall be as described below. All other provisions of WAC 220-340-730 not addressed herein, and unless otherwise amended, remain in effect:

- (a) Sea cucumber harvest using shellfish diver gear is allowed in Sea Cucumber District 1 and District 2-2.
- (b) The maximum cumulative landing of sea cucumbers for the period of January 22 through February 4, 2024, is 1,250 pounds per license from District 1.
- (c) The maximum cumulative landing of sea cucumbers for the period of January 22 through February 4, 2024, is 400 pounds per license from District 2-2.
