Draft Version of Ferry Terminal Rule

- (1) It is unlawful for any vessel to engage in any recreational crabbing or shrimping or commercial crabbing, shrimping, gillnetting or purse seine fishing within a rectangular-shaped closure area that extends 100 yards to either side of a Washington state ferry terminal and extending 400 yards into the water from the end of the terminal. In addition to the definitions outlined within RCW 79.160.060, the end of the terminal is defined as the point of interchange where the ferry docks to load and unload passengers.
- (2) For recreational fishers, a violation of this section is an infraction punishable under RCW 77.15.160. For commercial fishers, a violation of this section is a gross misdemeanor under RCW 77.15.550.
