Washington Department of Health has certified clams from these Razor Clam Areas 1, 3, 4, and 5 to be safe for human consumption. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.

## NEW SECTION

### **WAC 220-330-16000C Razor clams – Areas and Seasons.**

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-330-160, it is unlawful to take, dig for or possess razor clams taken for personal use from any beaches in any razor clam area except as provided for in this section:

- (1) Effective February 8 through February 14, 2025, razor clam digging is permissible in Razor Clam Areas defined in WAC 220-330-160 on dates and times listed below:

Area 1	February 8 through February 14	From 12:01 p.m. to 11:59 p.m.
Area 2	Closed	Closed
Area 3	February 8 through February 14	From 12:01 p.m. to 11:59 p.m.
Area 4	February 9, 10, 13, and 14	From 12:01 p.m. to 11:59 p.m.
Area 5	February 8, 11, and 12	From 12:01 p.m. to 11:59 p.m.
Area 6	Closed	Closed
Area 7	Closed	Closed

- (2) It is unlawful to dig for razor clams at any time in the Long Beach and Copalis Beach Clam sanctuaries defined in WAC 220-320-130.

## REPEALER
