WAC 220-315-03000G Smelt—Areas and Seasons

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-315-030, the Columbia River and Washington tributaries are closed to fishing for eulachon smelt except as provided below:

Open Dates: Wednesday, March 12, 2025 and Saturday, March 15, 2025, from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. (5-hour period).

Open Area: Cowlitz River (bank only) from the HWY 432 Bridge upstream to the Al

Helenberg Memorial Boat Ramp located approximately 1,300 feet upstream of

the HWY 411/A Street Bridge in Castle Rock.

Daily Limit: 10 pounds. Possession limit equal to one daily limit.

Gear: Smelt may be taken with dip net only.
