NEW SECTION

WAC 220-315-03000H Smelt—Areas and Seasons

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-315-030, effective March 15 through March 22, 2025, the Columbia River and Washington tributaries are closed to fishing for eulachon smelt except as provided below:

Open Dates: Saturday, March 15, 2025, Wednesday, March 19, 2025, and Saturday, March 22, 2025; from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. (5-hour period).

Open Area: Cowlitz River (bank only) from the Highway 432 Bridge upstream to the Al Helenberg Memorial Boat Ramp located approximately 1,300 feet upstream of the Highway 411/A Street Bridge in Castle Rock.

Daily Limit: 10 pounds. Possession limit is one daily limit.

Gear: Smelt may be taken with dip net only.
