WAC 220-330-16000I Razor clams – Areas and Seasons.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-330-160, it is unlawful to take, dig for or possess razor clams taken for personal use from any beaches in any razor clam area except as provided for in this section:

(1) Effective May 10 through May 15, 2025, razor clam digging is permissible in Razor Clam Areas defined in WAC 220-330-160 on dates and times listed below:

Area 1	May 10 through May 15	From 12:01 a.m. to 11:59 a.m.
Area 2	Closed	Closed
Area 3	May 10 through May 15	From 12:01 a.m. to 11:59 a.m.
Area 4	May 10, 13, and 14	From 12:01 a.m. to 11:59 a.m.
Area 5	May 11, 12, and 15	From 12:01 a.m. to 11:59 a.m.
Area 6	Closed	Closed

(2) It is unlawful to dig for razor clams at any time in the Long Beach and Copalis Beach Clam sanctuaries defined in WAC 220-320-130.
