WAC 220-312-05000E Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Eastside.

Effective May 20 through May 23, 2025, the following provisions of WAC 220-312-050, regarding salmon seasons in the Snake River shall be open as described in this section. All other provisions of WAC 220-312-050 remain in effect unless modified by emergency rule:

- (1) Snake River (Franklin/Walla Wall Counties): From Texas Rapids boat launch (located on the south side of the river upstream of the mouth of Tucannon River) to the fishing restriction boundary below Little Goose Dam and including the rock and concrete area between the juvenile bypass return pipe and little Goose Dam along the shoreline of the facility (including the walkway area locally known as "the Wall" in front of the juvenile collection facility): Salmon:
 - (a) Open May 20 and May 23, 2025
 - (b) Daily limit 4, of which up to 1 adult may be retained. Release all salmon other than hatchery Chinook.
 - (c) Night Closure.
 - (d) Barbless hooks required.
 - (e) Salmon may not be removed from the water unless retained as part of the daily limit.
- (2) Snake River (Franklin/Walla Wall Counties): From the South Bound Highway 12
 Bridge near Pasco upstream about 7 miles to the fishing restriction boundary below
 Ice Harbor Dam: Salmon:
 - (a) Open May 21 and May 22, 2025
 - (b) Daily limit 4, of which up to 1 adult may be retained. Release all salmon other than hatchery Chinook.
 - (c) Night Closure.
 - (d) Barbless hooks required.
 - (e) Salmon may not be removed from the water unless retained as part of the daily limit.
