**For the week beginning Sunday October 18, 2015 all areas are closed except as follows:**

### **Area 6D (Dungeness Bay) will be open to:**

**Skiff gillnets** using 5-inch minimum mesh size:

7 AM to 7 PM daily, Monday October 19 through Friday October 23

All Chinook must be released by cutting the ensnaring mesh.

### **Areas 7/7A (San Juan Islands/Point Roberts) will be open to:**

Please note a department issued Fish Friendly certification card is required to participate in any Area 7 or 7A commercial salmon fisheries.

**Reef nets:**

5 AM to 9PM daily Sunday, October 18 to Saturday, October 24

Must release all Chinook.

**Gillnets** using 6 ¼-inch minimum mesh size:

Beginning Monday October 19 open daily from 7 AM to midnight through Saturday October 24

**Purse seines** with a 5 inch strip:

Beginning Monday October 19 open daily from 7 AM to 6 PM through Saturday October 24.

Recovery boxes are required and purse seines must release all Chinook and coho.

### **Area 7B (Bellingham Bay) will be open to:**

**Gillnets** using 5-inch minimum mesh size:

Continuously through midnight Saturday October 24

**Purse seines** with a 5 inch strip:

Continuously through 6 PM Saturday, October 24

### **Area 8D (Tulalip Bay) will be open west of a line from Mission Point to Hermosa Point to:**

**Gillnets** using 5 inch minimum mesh size:

5 PM Sunday, October 18 to 9 AM Monday, October 19

5 PM Monday, October 19 to 9 AM Thursday, October 22

5 PM Thursday, October 22 to 9 AM Friday, October 23

**Purse seines** with a 5 inch strip:

Monday, October 19 from 7 AM to 6 PM

Purse seines must release all Chinook.

**Area 9A (Port Gamble Bay) will be open to:**

**Skiff gillnets** with nets not to exceed 600 feet in length and 60 meshes in depth using 5-inch minimum mesh, continuously through 7 PM Saturday, October 31. All Chinook must be released by cutting the ensnaring mesh.

**Areas 10 & 11 (Seattle and Tacoma) will be open to:**

**Gillnets** using 6 ¼ inch minimum mesh:

5 PM Tuesday, October 20 to 9 AM Wednesday, October 21

5 PM Thursday, October 22 to 9 AM Friday, October 23

**Purse seines** with a 5 inch strip:

Monday, October 19 from 7 AM to 6 PM

Purse seines must release all Chinook and coho.

**Areas 12 & 12B (Hood Canal) will be open to:**

**Gillnets** using 6 ¼ inch minimum mesh:

Tuesday, October 20 from 7 AM to 8 PM

Thursday, October 22 from 7 AM to 8 PM

**Purse seines** with a 5 inch strip:

Monday, October 19 from 7 AM to 6 PM

Purse seines must release all Chinook.
