

# PUGET SOUND COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERIES HOTLINE (360) 902-2500

2017-24, Week 45 Tuesday November 7<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 p.m. [read by: Kendall Henry]

For the remainder of the week beginning Sunday November 5<sup>th</sup> all areas are closed except as follows:

#### Areas 7/7A (San Juan Islands and Point Roberts) will be open to: Reef Nets

5 AM to 9 PM Daily through November 11<sup>th</sup> Must release all Chinook.

**Gillnets** using 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>-inch minimum mesh size:

7AM to Midnight Daily through November 11th

**Purse seines** with a 5 inch strip:

7AM to 5PM Daily through November 11th

Recovery boxes are required and purse seines must release all Chinook and coho.

# Area 7B (Bellingham Bay) will be open to:

**Gillnets** using 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> - inch minimum mesh size: 6 AM Monday, November 6<sup>th</sup> to 4 PM Friday November 10<sup>th</sup>

### Purse seines with a 5 inch strip:

7 AM Monday, November 6<sup>th</sup> to 4 PM Friday November 10<sup>th</sup> Purse seines must release all Chinook.

The Whatcom Creek Zone (waters east of a line from Post Point to the flashing red light at the west entrance to Squalicum Harbor) is open for both gillnets and purse seines, continuously through 4 PM Friday, November 24<sup>th</sup>.

Area 8D (Tulalip Bay) will be open west of a line from Mission Point to Hermosa Point to:
Gillnets using 5 inch minimum mesh
6 AM Thursday, November 9<sup>th</sup> to 4 PM Friday, November 10<sup>th</sup>

**Purse seines** with a 5 inch strip: Thursday, November 9<sup>th</sup> from 7 AM to 5 PM Purse seines must release all Chinook.

## Areas 10 & 11 (Seattle and Tacoma) will be open to:

**Gillnets** using 6 ¼ inch minimum mesh: 4 PM Wednesday, November 8<sup>th</sup> to 7 AM Thursday, November 9<sup>th</sup>

Purse seines with a 5 inch strip:

Thursday, November 9<sup>th</sup> from 7 AM to 5 PM Purse seines must release all Chinook and coho.

Areas 12, 12B, & 12C (Hood Canal) is currently closed. The non-treaty share at the current inseason run size estimate of 966,000 chum has been harvested.
