Notice: The date for Monday's Hood Canal fishery has been corrected. There are no other changes.

For the week beginning Sunday, October 28, all areas are closed except as follows:

7B (Bellingham Bay) will be open to:

Gillnets using 5-inch minimum mesh: Continuously through Saturday, November 3.

Purse seines with a 5 inch strip: Continuously through Saturday, November 3. Must release Chinook.

Area 8D (Tulalip Bay) will be open west of a line from Mission Point to Hermosa Point to:

Gillnets using 5 inch minimum mesh size:

5 p.m. Sunday, October 28 to 9 a.m. Monday, October 29;
5 p.m. Monday, October 29 to 9 a.m. Thursday, November 1; and
5 p.m. Thursday, November 1 to 9 a.m. Friday, November 2.

Purse seines with a 5 inch strip:

Wednesday, October 31 from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Purse seines must release all Chinook.

9A (Port Gamble Bay) will be open to:

Skiff gillnets with nets not to exceed 600 feet in length and 60 meshes in depth using 5-inch minimum mesh, continuously through Saturday, November 3. Release all Chinook.

Areas 10 & 11 (Seattle and Tacoma) will be open to:

Gillnets using 6 ¼ inch minimum mesh:

5 p.m. Sunday, October 28 to 9 a.m. Monday, October 29
5 p.m. Thursday, November 1 to 9 a.m. Friday, November 2

Purse seines with a 5 inch strip:

Wednesday, October 31 from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Purse seines must release all Chinook and coho.

Areas 12 & 12B (Hood Canal) will be open to:

Gillnets using 6 ¼ inch minimum mesh from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. daily:

Monday, October 29 and Thursday, November 1

Purse seines with a 5 inch strip:

Wednesday, October 31 from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Purse seines must release all Chinook.

Please note the Hazel Point/Misery Point area is closed to all gears.
