KIDS FISH-IN EVENT GUIDELINES

- All fishing gear and bait will be provided. No personal fishing gear will be allowed.
- **WILDLIFE** Please arrive 30 minutes before your session to check in.
 - Due to limited fishing area, please limit number of non-fishing family members to less than 5.
 - Kids will be fishing in a netted area. However, catch is not guaranteed.
 - Parents are encouraged to help their child(ren) fish. However the child is the one that should be fishing.
 - No dogs, bikes, or strollers will be allowed in the fishing area, for safety considerations.
 - Once the limit is caught, each child needs to leave the fishing area and proceed to the cleaning station. Catch and release will not be allowed and will result in immediate departure from the fishing area. (Fish may be donated to a local charity, arranged by the organizing entity at the fish cleaning station.)
 - Time slots are assigned on a first come, first serve basis. Once you are registered you cannot change your scheduled time
 - If you would like to volunteer or donate to this event call the recreation office at 442-5400.
