

**2018 Trout and Kokanee Stocking Plan for Region 1**

*Stocking allotments and timing are subject to change without notice*

**Stocking Month:** Exact dates are not known at this time. Stocking timing will be left to the convenience of the hatcheries.

**Fish Species:** CT=cutthroat trout, LCT=lakontan cutthroat BT=brown trout, EBT=western brook trout, TEBT = triploid eastern brook trout, RB=rainbow trout, TRB=triploid rainbow trout, KOK=kokanee, and TT=tiger trout

**Fishing Season:** OD=4th Saturday in April, YR=Year-Round, SO=statewide stream opener (regardless of the season listed, it is the **Anglers responsibility** to check the "Washington Sport Fishing Rules" pamphlet to assure compliance with the regulations).

**Catchables:** Trout that have been reared at WDFW facilities and are 2.0 to 2.5 fish per pound in size.

**Put, Grow & Take:** Trout that have been reared at WDFW facilities and are 2.6 to 10 fish per pound in size.

**Jumbos:** Trout that have been reared at WDFW facilities that weigh 1 pound or more each. Note: includes brood fish.

**Triplods:** Triploid trout that have been purchased by the WDFW. Each fish weighs about 1.5 pounds.

**Fry/Fingerling:** Trout or kokanee that have been reared at WDFW facilities that were released at 10 to 600 fish per pound. Trout fry/fingerlings released in 2017 will be harvestable in 2018. Kokanee fry/fingerlings released in 2017 will be harvestable in fall 2019/spring 2020.
