Name of Proposal: GEORGE CREEK ACCESS ROAD RESTRUCTURE

Description of Proposal: Project proposes to Armor two creek crossings to bypass a segment of washed out road along George Creek. The banks would be Armored with 6"+ cobble and do not intend to disturb the stream bottom. Plan is to cross the creek primarily with ATV's. A bypass road is required for traveling to and from the upper reaches of George Creek in order to perform fence maintenance and week control. Primary vehicles using the bypass will be ATV's and weed spray equipment.
