DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Name of Proposal: MALLARD MARSH WETLAND RESTORATION

Description of Proposal: The main objective of this project is to restore floodplain habitat on this property to the extent possible, given the current conditions. This project will greatly enhance 12 acres of floodplain connectivity through removing drain tiles, restoring degraded in-stream channel profiles, installation of a fish friendly water control structures, a low level berm, spillways, and planting of native shrubs/trees. These elements will facilitate in the restoration of the natural hydrological regime, recruitment of large woody debris, improved water quality, increased nutrient cycling and biotic diversity. Several portions of French Creek upstream and downstream of the project area are currently on the Department of Ecology's 303(d) list and this project will help restore lower temperatures, increase dissolved oxygen levels and filter unwanted nutrients.

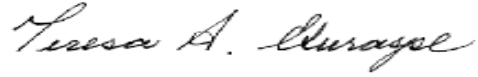
