# DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Name of Proposal: HOODSPORT HATCHERY ADA FISHING ENHANCEMENT PROJECT

**Description of Proposal:** The Hood Canal shorelines adjacent to the Hoodsport Hatchery are a popular fishing destination during fall months, but no ADA access exists. The Hoodsport Hatchery ADA Fishing Enhancement Project will provide fishing access to ADA qualified persons at Hoodsport Hatchery. The specific components of this project are:

- Replace existing grated walkway along south boundary of the hatchery, paralleling Finch Creek, with American with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant grating. Approximately 200 sq. ft of grating to be replaced.
- Replace existing chain link fence with ADA handrail and create fishing access slots along SE corner. Approximately 20 lineal feet of fence to be replaced with handrail.
- Replace existing 8'x9'grated ramp up to the walkway with ADA compliant 8'x 18' ramp including handrail.
- Construct new over water ADA fishing platform over entrance to existing fish ladder. From south hatchery wall extending to fish ladder wall at the mouth of Finch Creek. Over water structure will be constructed of aluminum or fiberglass grating, galvanized supports bolted and epoxied to existing walls. ADA surfacing, grades, widths, and handrails for fishing access will be installed. Platform will consist of a 3'x6' gangway leading from the hatchery to the ladder wall, to a 5' by 5' resting platform, turning a 90 degree angle along the ladder entrance wall to a 3' by 16' gangway, leading to a 6'x10' platform supported by the hatchery wall and the ladder intake wall.
- This project will include striping of one or two ADA parking spaces at the hatchery.
- There is no in water work, no concrete work other than epoxy needed to fix supports to existing concrete wall, and no earth work.
- There is no opportunity for sediment delivery; all surfaces will be grated for light passage. The new structure is primarily over the fish ladder intake channel, so there will be minimal impact to the mouth of Finch Creek.
- This project is a modification of existing structures at the Hatchery.
- Estimated cost for this project is \$10,000 in materials and \$20,000 in labor.
