DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Name of Proposal: MISERY POINT BOAT RAMP REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Description of Proposal: Remove the existing on-grade deterioration concrete ramp in its entirety and replace with an elevated deck concrete ramp. Install maker piles to the west of the ramp to indicate the extent of the ramp to warn boaters of the location of the ramp. Install four tie-off piles to the east of the ramp. Remove and replace existing vault toilet facility. Upgrade the two existing parking lot lights. Fog seal and re-stripe the asphalt parking lot. Provide ADA compliant accessibility. Re-grade and gravel the existing overflow parking area. Install an energy dissipation area for stormwater. Install an oil/water separator for stormwater treatment. Install pipe bollards at the north edge of pavement. (details in checklist)
