DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

Name of Proposal: YARR NOXIOUS VEGETATION REMOVAL – DRAINAGE
INFRASTRUCTURE MAINTENANCE

Description of Proposal: Reed Canarygrass and European Bittersweet have grown into channel, causing high water table in adjacent farm fields and lowering dissolved oxygen levels. It is floating mats of vegetation rooted into streambank clogging low flow channel. Project will remove this vegetation using tracked excavator with hydraulic clamshell. Vegetation will be removed without channel excavation – vegetation is grabbed at or just below water surface and pulled out. Vegetation removed will be spread away from stream channel and left to decompose
