DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

Name of Proposal: RESECK FARM POND MAINTENANCE

Description of Proposal: Maintenance of existing farm pond. Remove accumulated sediment from farm pond, approximately 50' wide x 100' long x 8' deep (1500 cy yds). Last done in early 1990s. Sediment will be placed on old spoils adjacent to pond and revegetated. Stream water entering pond will be diverted during pond cleanout. Farm pond has silted in due to high sediment load from upstream industrial forestland. Project will remove sediment and recreate open water wildlife habitat. Sediment captured in pond and removed is prevented from entering Salmon creek summer chum salmon spawning areas.

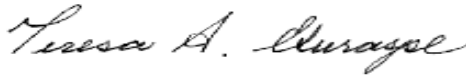
