DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

Name of Proposal: STATEWIDE FISH RETENTION SCREEN MAINTENANCE

Description of Proposal: This SEPA is for the maintenance of all WDFW fish retention screens statewide. Currently WDFW is responsible for the maintenance of these screens and associated structures. Typical maintenance will include inspection of structures, and clearing screens and entrance areas of woody debris, leaves, trash and miscellaneous floating objects. Other maintenance activities would include cleaning structures associated with screens, repairing vandalism and other damage, lubricating moving parts, replacing seals, inspecting to verify screens are fish tight, and monitoring for clear fish passage. See Table 1 (checklist) for locations, counties and WDFW Regional designation of currently owned and maintained fish retention screens. If additional fish retention screens are developed, their maintenance will also be covered under this SEPA. Currently there are 28 locations maintained by WDFW maintenance crews.
