DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

Name of Proposal: FRESHWATER SLOUGH LEVEE REPAIR

Description of Proposal: WDFW proposes to repair the existing levee that was damaged during the 2006 floods. Approximately 40 linear feet (approximately 300 cubic yards) will be repaired by regrading the waterward slope. Native vegetation such as willows will be planted to improve habitat and help stabilize the slope. Also, the backside of the levee will be filled with the material removed from the waterward side and regraded to maintain the levee's width.

Location of Proposal, including street, if any: From I-5 north take exit 221 or the Lake McMurry exit, head west on the Pioneer Hwy. Go over the interstate and take the first right onto Fir Island Road through Conway and about 1.8 miles to left on Wylie Road go to the end of Wylie and stay left onto the Wildlife Area. From this point, WDFW personnel will escort visitors by boat to the project site.

There is no street address for the proposed project. The closest town, Conway, is approximately 2 miles to the northeast, Washington, Skagit County; Section 03, Township 24 North, Range 33 EastWM
