DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

Name of Proposal: COURNYER LANDSLIDE DEBRIS REMOVAL

Description of Proposal: Cleaning landslide material from original stream channel. Channel cleaning will begin just past Pleasant Valley County Road culvert's outlet invert and will continue downstream for approximately 682 feet. Maximum cleaning depth will be 3 feet with a total amount of approximately 400 cubic yards of landslide debris removed from stream.
