DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

Name of Proposal: ELOIKA LAKE ACCESS RENOVATION

Description of Proposal: This project includes the renovation of an existing boat launch ramp and access site on Eloika Lake. This single ramp is scheduled to be replaced and an associated boarding float will be installed. A concrete walkway and additional ADA parking stalls will also be installed. The specific components of this project are listed in the checklist.

Location of Proposal, including street, if any: The Eloika Lake Public Access Site is located at the end of East Bridges Road next to Eloika Lake. This site is reached by turning off of Highway 2 onto East Bridges Road, and proceeding 3/4 miles to the access site. The project site is in Spokane County, Section 10, Township 29 North, Range 43 East WM, Southwest 1/4. The parcel number is 39103.0122

Lead Agency: Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW)
